Craftsmanship and Quality

The Quality of a Renaissance Student that I believe I could benefit the most from improving is Craftsmanship and Quality. The school describes these two qualities as the ability to complete work with consistent care for organization, detail and accuracy as well as the capability to craft, refine and polish a piece of work until it is of meeting quality. The second piece of work that could have been improved by using craftsmanship and quality is my geometry proof project. I received a 2 on this project because I didn't finish it and i didn't complete the self-reflection that was required at the end. What I need to do in the future is to begin large projects ahead of time and put more effort towards doing them the right way and not just rushing last minute to get part of it done.

The third and final piece of work that I am going to show is my LT1 westward expansion apology letter. For this essay we had to analyze how different groups of Americans justified and experienced westward expansion. For my grade I got a 2.5 which is approaching the target but I could've gotten a much better grade if I would've used craftsmanship and quality. In the essay we had to use what we learned in class about westward expansion, such as, what issues occurred, why they occurred and what the costs were of what had happened as a result of it. We learned about all of the people who were effected in the westward expansion, what Americans got out of it and how we benefitted from all of the things that occurred. I found a lot of this

information to be very interesting and important but I did not express this in my essay. I could have used my interest in what we were learning to be more detailed and accurate in my writing. Had I used my notes and classwork to include specific details and information, I would have used craftsmanship and quality in the writing process and probably would have gotten a better grade for doing that.

I know that I possess the ability to use craftsmanship and quality to help me be successful because I have done it on the football field. What I need to do now is take what I have learned from my success in sports and apply it to school. I need to make hard work a habit for me in the classroom and begin to value the school work I complete. I will also make a commitment to completing my rough drafts on time so that I can check and revise my work. Doing this will improve my grades and help me to develop better habits of work. I will create smart goals for myself and I will try to do a better job of managing my time between school, sports, and work.
